



The Silver Brush Award

Every year the Red River Watercolor Society has the opportunity to vote one active member who is in good standing, Club Member of the Year.

The criteria for Member of the Year recommend that nominees will have demonstrated significant achievement in one or more of the following categories:

- Significant contribution or service to RRWS during the preceding program year.
- Extraordinary personal contribution in the promotion/advocacy of watermedia with RRWS
- Leadership in bringing together the varied interests, expertise and levels of artists in watermedia in RRWS events and activities.
- Showed commitment to the expansion and growth of RRWS with the creation of new annual, quarterly or monthly events for our members to participate in.

The Winner receives a certificate or similar token of appreciation. No monetary award is given. The winner is announced at our December Induction meeting which is the last meeting of the financial and board year.

The Nomination/Selection Process directs that candidates will be nominated by their colleagues. A form will need to be completed and submitted to RRWS either by mail or e-mail. This can be downloaded from our website, www.RedRiverWS.org.

No current member of the Executive Board or selection committee is eligible for nomination during their tenure on the Board/Committee.
